Paper folding art is fun and beautiful! It has long been recognized for its educational value, particularly in understanding mathematical concepts, especially geometry and fractions. Paper folding existed as early as the Middle Ages in Europe, but what we know today as *origami* originated in China and spread to Korea and Japan.

Beginners will learn basic origami folding techniques, action origami, and simple modular origami. They will make ninja stars, cranes, spaceships, boats, airplanes, flowers, origami balls, polyhedra, and more....
